Renzenbrink & Partner advises former shareholders of LANCOM on final acquisition by Rohde & Schwarz

The shareholders of LANCOM Holding GmbH had previously reached an agreement with Rohde & Schwarz on its participation in LANCOM Holding GmbH in autumn 2016. The technology enterprise has now taken over the remaining shares in the German network infrastructure producer. LANCOM will operate as a subsidiary company of Rohde & Schwarz and will be managed by founder Ralf Koenzen as well as co-director Stefan Herrlich.

LANCOM Holding GmbH is the sole shareholder of LANCOM Systems GmbH, a leading producer of network solutions such as routers, gateways and WLAN solutions in Germany for both government and business customers. The company is located in Würselen (close to Aachen) and its products are used as solutions for both national and international small and mid-market businesses as well as public authorities and large corporate entities. In 2015, LANCOM won the well-known Sustained Excellence Award from Deloitte for its long-term growth and consistent entrepreneurial spirit.

Electronics group Rohde & Schwarz is a provider of test and measurement equipment, broadcast and media equipment, I/T security, secure communications and radio monitoring as well as radiolocation equipment and is considered a leader in this field of expertise worldwide. The firm has approximately 9,900 employees and generated revenue of EUR 1.83 billion during the financial year 2014/15 (from July until June).
